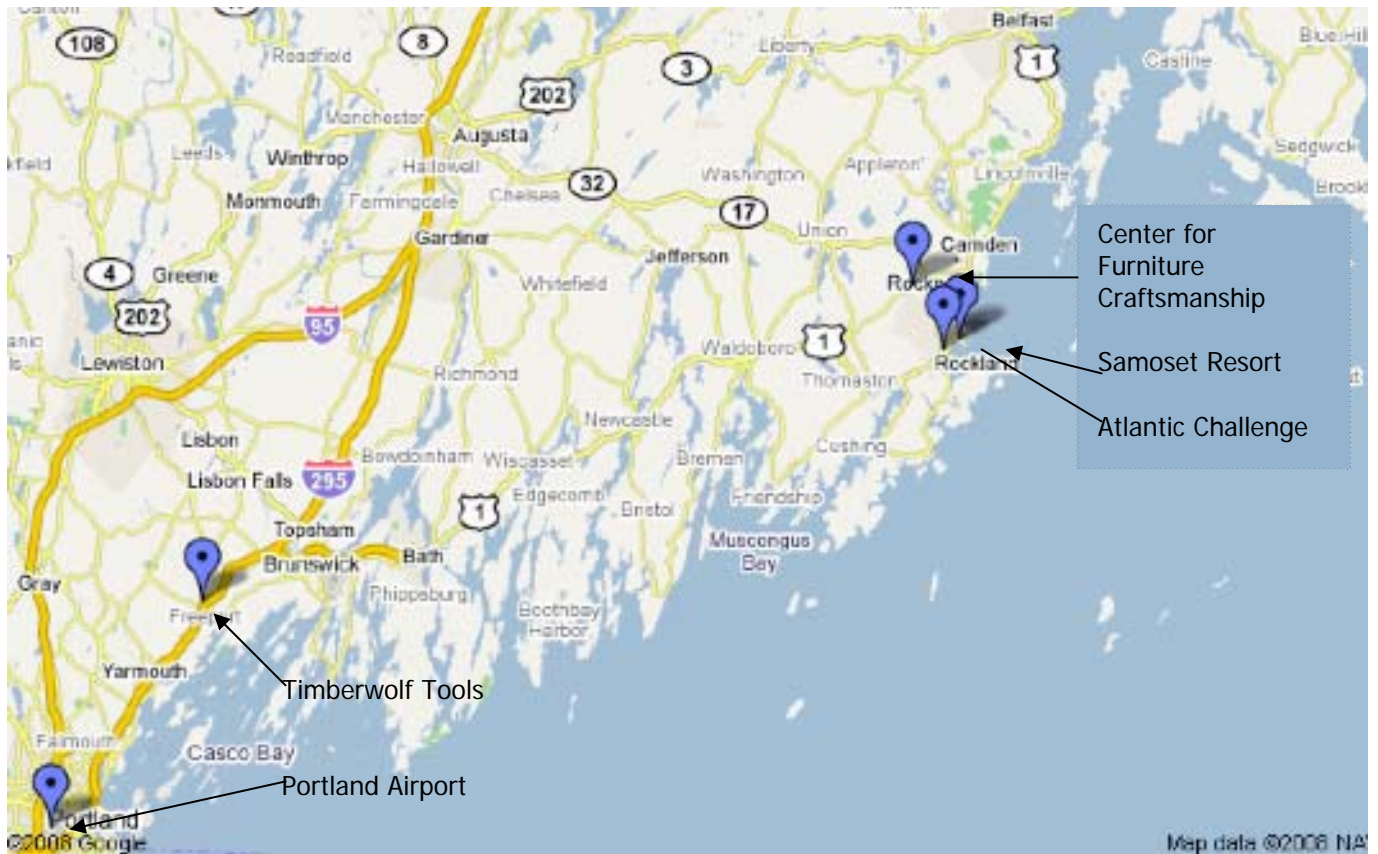


Things to Do on the Way to the Eastern Conference

Driving from Boston

- Take I-95 North through New Hampshire into Maine.
- Just before Portland, take Exit 44 onto 295 North.
- Take Exit 28 to Brunswick/Route 1 North.
- Follow Route 1 North to Warren (about 45 miles).
- Turn left on Route 90 at blinking light. Go 6.5 miles.
- The entrance to the school is on the right. If you pass it, take a right onto Mill St., where there is a second entrance.

Bring your friends and your appetite for tools. You will also be able to see photo albums of past projects by Houses & Barns by John Libby as well as the 180-year-old hand-hewn 60 ft wide king post trusses that support the roof system of John Libby's shop.

Directions from Portland: (Travel time, approx 20 minutes)

- Take 295 North, to exit 22.
- Turn right at the end of the exit ramp (*away from town*).
- When the road ends, take a right onto Route 136.
- We are the first road on the right as you are heading up the hill after the storage facility. Post Road.
- We are in the big barn at the end; you can't miss us.

Directions from the Samoset in Rockland: (Travel time, approx 80 minutes)

- Take Route 1 South (approximately 50 minutes).
- Stay on Route 1 when it turns into a highway (in Bath).
- Stay straight on the highway, following signs to Brunswick.
- At the light (Cumberland Farms will be on your right), take a right onto Pleasant St.
- Follow Pleasant St. until it turns into 295 South.
- Take exit 22 (the first Freeport exit is about 10 minutes south of Brunswick).
- Turn left at the end of the exit ramp (*away from town*).
- When the road ends, take a right onto Route 136.
- We are the first road on the right as you are heading up the hill after the storage facility. Post Road.
- We are in the big barn at the end; you can't miss us.
