

Hertzier Barn Project - Springfield, Ohio

July 7-21, 2007

The Barn Repair and Reassembly Workshop will use a combination of salvaged and new timbers and include training on stabilization, jacking, replacement of sills, repair and/or replacement of joints, flooring, girders, queen posts, braces, purlins and other barn frame components; laying a new floor at the sill level; modification of the barn frame to fit the existing foundation; and cutting and installing common rafters. Meals and campsite are included. The workshop begins at noon July 7.

Tuition for the two-week workshop is \$250. Tuition may be waived for professional timber framers and/or individuals who have participated in previous TFG projects. If seeking a tuition waiver, please provide a résumé, including recent timber frame projects.

Participants will be required to sign a "Liability and Release Waiver" and will be asked for permission to publish their image and name.
