## CAMP LETTS RENDEZVOUS

### GENERAL EVENT REGISTRATION

You may register for one of two options to attend the Camp Letts Rendezvous: either the five-day All-Week Package (arrival for Monday dinner, departure after breakfast Sunday) or the Weekend Package (arrival for Thursday dinner, departure after breakfast on Sunday). Every participant must register for one of these two options.

The Event Registration fee includes participation in all the events shown in blue in the schedule. Events in orange require an additional fee.

All Event Registrations fees include meals and lodging. The Camp Letts staff serves three well-balanced meals daily in their clean, spacious dining hall. Nutritious menus include fresh fruits, low fat milk, vegetarian options and a fresh salad bar. Meals are served family style.

Lodging includes bunk space in one of the many Camp lodges. Each lodge has two bunkrooms separated by a central lounge. Each bunkroom has six beds and a bathroom with shower, toilet and sink.

If you wish to share your room with a certain person, be sure to indicate your roommate in the space provided below. We will try to accommodate all requests and will assign rooms on a first-come-first-served basis. Once the main lodges are full, late registrants may be assigned to Rustic Village lodges

under the trees that do not have plumbing, but occupants may use the bathrooms in the pool house and shower house. If you prefer to camp, you may do so outside of the lodge you are assigned to; you may use the bunk and lodge for storing your gear and in case of inclement weather. All Rendezvous participants will be assigned a bunk. There are no special rates for commuters who choose not to stay at Camp Letts, nor are there options for one-day attendance or not taking the meal plan.

### SPECIAL WORKSHOPS & CERTIFICATION COURSES

Participants may also register for one or more special workshops and certification courses for which additional tuition fees are charged. Because we are providing dedicated, intensive and professional instruction, enrollment is limited; so register early! You must have registered for the appropriate package above to participate in these special events.

Participants in the Special Workshops and Certification Courses are expected to fully attend these events. Schedule permitting, you are welcome to attend all the events shown in blue in the schedule since these are included in the event Registration Fee.
