



## Share your stories: TFG member slide show

The member slide show is a favorite event at TFG conferences. Through the images shared by our members, we are inspired, instructed, and sometimes, amused! The projects shown and stories told often spark connections both old and new. Above all, we think about the work we do as a community. Please consider sharing your work.

### General Guidelines:

- Presenters may show up to ten (10) images of recent timber framing work.
- No commercial logos are permitted.
- Images must be of work in which you actively or directly participated. The only exception to this rule is for images of historic joinery (100 years or older) for purposes of documentation and subsequent submission to the TTRAG archive.
- You must be present to talk about your images.

### Preparation:

- Images may be of one project or of several but must involve timber framing.
- Thumb drives must be clearly labeled with your name, phone number, and/or email address.
- Submitted drives should not contain other files.
- Images should be numbered using two-digit file names to preserve your intended image order. Please use "01.jpg" – DON'T use "1.jpg." Images will be automatically renamed and sequenced based on the sequence of the upload using this form, so the two-digit labeling system is essential to maintain your preferred order of presentation.
- No more than ten (10) images will be accepted. Additional images will be omitted from the show.
- Do not use multiple images on the same slide.

### Submission:

- Digital images may be submitted prior to the conference by emailing them to [cuba@tfguild.org](mailto:cuba@tfguild.org) (Please email them at least a week prior to the conference)
- Or at the event on a thumb drive.
- Images submitted at the event should be dropped off at the TFG conference registration desk as early as possible and no later than noon on Friday.

### Presentation:

- You will narrate your images.
- Images will be presented in the order in which they are received.
- Time limits for presentations will be enforced. The time allotted for each presentation will be determined by the total time allotted for the slide show divided by the number of submissions.
- Watch for your name in the group list on the screen and be sure to be in the front of the room before it is your turn to present.
